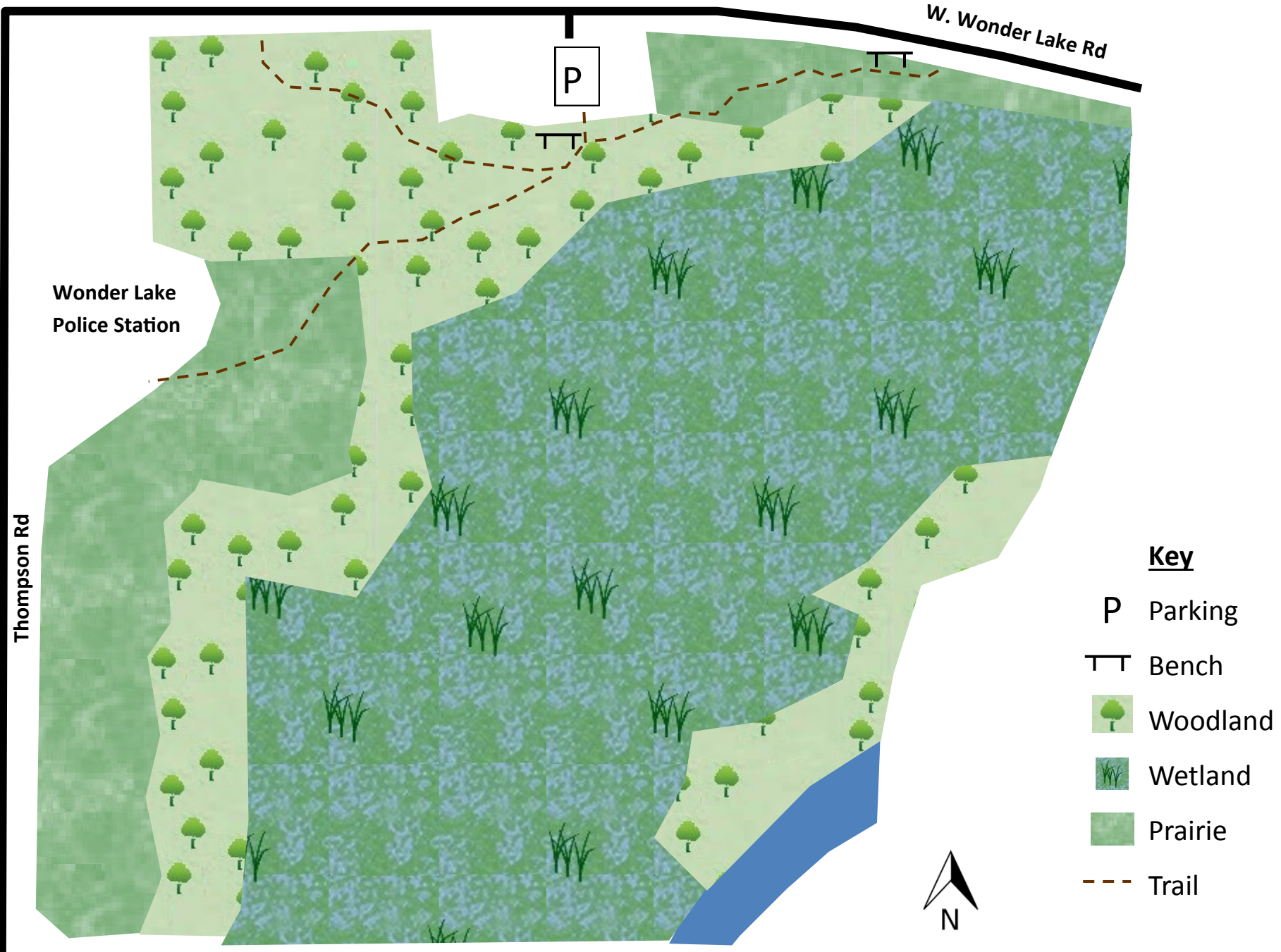


Wonder Lake Sedge Meadow

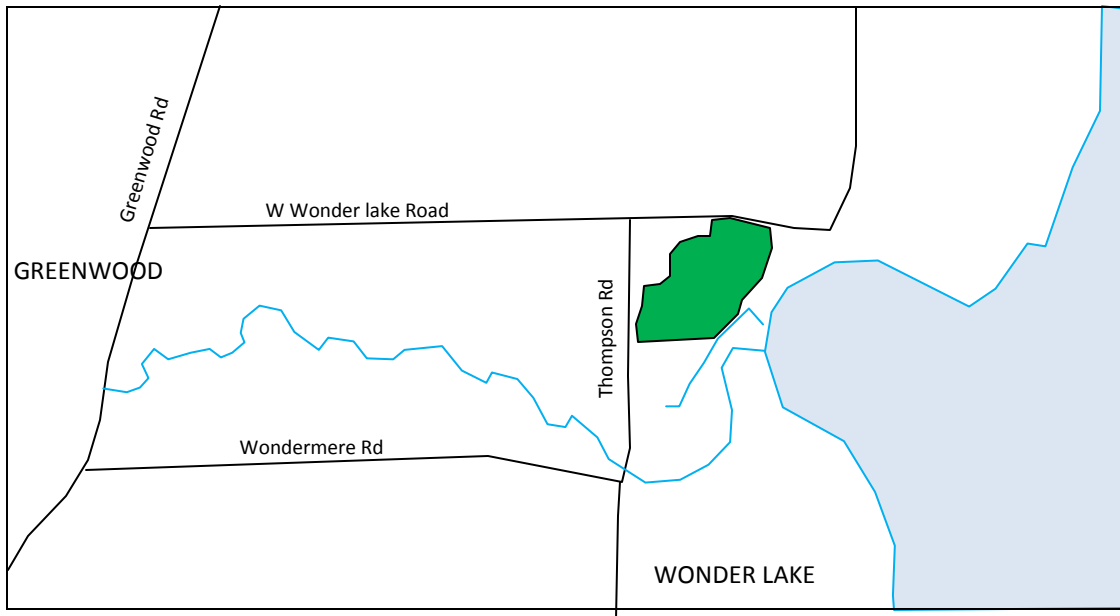

INFO AND HISTORY ABOUT SITE

In 2006, these 28 acres of sedge meadow and oak savanna were permanently protected by TLC in partnership with the Village of Wonder Lake and Neumann Homes. A small trail leads through the oak woods that is covered with Dutchman's Britches and Trilliums in the spring. If you're feeling adventurous, feel free to walk down into the sedge meadow that occupies most of the middle of the preserve. The terrain is lumpy, since this area was never plowed. Ancient hummocks made by sedges are the cause of the lumps, but it's worth getting wet feet when you see the abundance of wildflowers waiting there! The diversity and pristine qualities of this site has led it to being classified as a "McHenry County Natural Area"- a status reserved for only the highest quality remnant natural areas left in the county.
