



TLC Compass Course at Wolf Oak Woods 9100 IL Route 120 Woodstock, IL

Directions

Your goal is to visually spot the 10 animals that have been placed off trail as you walk the loop clockwise at Wolf Oak Woods. You do not leave the trail.

Begin at the parking lot. Post #1 is a short distance along the trail heading toward Route 120.

Read the Directional Degree provided on the post.

If you are using a phone compass, stand by the post and hold your phone horizontally (our preference). Turn your body until the red line at the top reads the degree given on the post.

If you are using a magnetic compass, hold the compass horizontally to just under your chest. Dial the degree. Turn your body until the red needle and the red arrow inside the compass dial line up. You are now facing the correct direction.

NOW: Distances can vary from very short to 60 yards. Height can vary from waist high to 12 feet. If you're having trouble locating the figure, the photos provided may help. We just want you to have fun outdoors on this little experimental adventure!

Follow the path. Stop at each post. The trail will turn to the West and run parallel to Route 120, circling clockwise back to the Wolf Oak near the parking lot. Let us know of any suggestions you may have for improvement.

1	180 degrees	30 yds.	Orange beaked Macaw
2	315 degrees	60 yds.	Pink elephant
3	185 degrees	25 yds. difficult	Donkey
4	45 degrees	Just look	Bear
5	315 degrees	low	3 inch human figure
6	320 degrees	Far!	White bear
7	200 degrees	Just look	Goose
8	300 degrees	30 yds. difficult	Tan bear
9	70 degrees	Close by	White dog
10	180 degrees	Close by	Small koala
